CPT Soomin Jung graduated from the University of California, Los Angeles (UCLA) in June 2015 with a Bachelor of Arts in Anthropology and a minor in Asian Languages, Mandarin Chinese. She was commissioned in the United States Army as a Signal Corps Officer from the UCLA Reserve Officer Training Corps (ROTC).

CPT Jung's first assignment was to 1-37 Field Artillery Battalion, 1-2 Stryker Brigade Combat Team in Joint Base Lewis-McChord, WA, where she served as the Battalion S6 OIC. She was later assigned to the First Corps as the Main Command Post Signal Platoon Leader and Headquarters Support Company Executive Officer. She was eventually appointed as the Network Officer to the Intelligence, Information Operations, Cyber, Electronic Warfare, and Space (I2CEWS) Battalion, 1st Multi-Domain Task Force (MDTF) for 19 months, supporting combined and joint missions in the Indo-Pacific Command Area of Operations. Upon completing SCCC, CPT Jung assumed command of the United States Army Network Enterprise Center, Seoul Air Base (USANEC – Seoul AB), 41st Signal Battalion in Yongsan Base, Republic of Korea for 24 months. She is currently serving as the Action Response Center Battle Captain for the United States Army Regional Cyber Center – Pacific (USARCC-P) at Fort Shafter, HI and has been recently selected to serve as a Foreign Area Officer (FAO) with regional Area of Concentration (AOC) Asia-Pacific (48P).

CPT Jung's military education includes the Signal Basic Officer Leader Course (SBOLC), the Signal Captain's Career Course (SCCC), and the Army Space Cadre Basic Course.

CPT Jung's awards and decorations include: Meritorious Service Medal; Army Commendation Medal (4-OLC); Joint Service Achievement Medal; Army Achievement Medal (1-OLC); Army Superior Unit Award; National Defense Service Medal; Global War On Terrorism Service Medal; Korean Defense Service Medal; Army Service Ribbon; Overseas Service Ribbon; and the Army Basic Space Badge.
