PLEASE NOTE:

CHANGE TO SECURITY/ACCESS TO FORT SHAFTER AS OF MARCH 26th

- **Individuals with a Common Access Card (CAC), Government ID, Retired Military ID, or Fort Shafter DBIDS (other installations not accepted) can show their badge at the main Fort Shafter Gate (Buckner Gate) and will be granted access to Fort Shafter.** You do not have to go to Tripler to get a guest pass.
- **IMPORTANT UPDATE!** If you submit your PII security information to us by **Friday, March 27, 2026**, our Event Access List will be at the Tripler Pass & ID Office. The Tripler (Jarrett White Rd) exit is just past Fort Shafter. Because of world events, and heightened Force Protection Conditions, all non-badged guests must go to the Tripler Pass & ID Office to get a pass. Your pass will be good from April 14 - April 16, 2026. Directions to the Tripler Pass & ID Office are below. We will provide everyone on our access list the official visit request letter via email before April 14th. You need to show a digital copy of the letter to the guard at the Tripler Pass & ID Office. **Please have your Real ID Driver's License, Valid Vehicle Registration (or Rental Car Agreement), Current**

Safety Inspection, and Proof of Insurance to show the Pass & ID Office guard.

- **The Tripler Pass & ID Office is open 24/7:** To avoid lines and delays get your pass on April 14, 2026.
- **NOTE THAT THE TRUSTED TRAVELER PROGRAM IS SUSPENDED:** The Trusted Traveler Program, which previously allowed CAC holders to "vouch" for passengers without individual passes, has been **suspended** at U.S. Army Garrison Hawaii (USAG-HI) installations due to increased security measures. This means every adult in the vehicle (18+) must have their own valid Department of Defense (DoD) ID or an approved visitor pass to enter.

DIRECTIONS

FROM WAIKIKI: (approximately 20 minutes)

**DIRECTIONS TO THE TRIPLER PASS & ID OFFICE & THEN TO FORT SHAFTER
(IF YOU NEED A GUEST PASS)**

- Take H-1 West towards Waianae.
- Follow signs and take a slight left at H-201 West towards Aiea.
- Follow signs for Tripler Army Medical Center (Exit sign says Puuloa Rd./Tripler Hosp.)
- You will go up the hill and be directed to the Visitors Center on the right-hand side.
- Once you have your guest pass follow the road around the hospital and back down the hill.

- Exit Tripler Army Medical Center and follow signs down to the freeway
- Merge onto H-1 toward Pearl Harbor (Westbound)
- Take the Moanalua Freeway (H-201 West) exit toward Fort Shafter
- Continue on H-201 and follow signs for Fort Shafter
- Take the Fort Shafter exit and proceed to the Main Gate.
- Once on Fort Shafter follow directions below for the Hale Ikena Community Center.

DIRECTIONS TO FORT SHAFTER MAIN GATE/HALE IKENA COMMUNITY CENTER FROM WAIKIKI (IF YOU HAVE A CAC, RETIRED MILITARY ID, OR DBIDS)

- Take the H1-West from Waikiki.
- On H1-West keep left at the fork to merge onto H-201 W, follow signs for Interstate H-201 W/Aiea/Fort Shafter.
- Next, take a right onto Exit 4 Fort Shafter/Ahua Street onto Kikowaena Road.
- Turn right through the Main Gate (Buckner Gate) onto Funston Road.
- You will be funneled down the hill to the Main Gate.
- Once the guard has seen your guest pass and your Real ID, you will drive back up the hill and make a right at the stop sign back onto Funston Road.
- From Funston Road you will make a left on Carter Drive from left turn only lane.
- Follow Carter Drive and take sharp right up hill onto Morton Drive.
- The entrance to Hale Ikena is on left.

PARKING & PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION

Open parking is available in front of the Hale Ikena.
Public transportation such as Ubers, or Taxis, will not be allowed to access Fort Shafter.

SHIPPING & EQUIPMENT INFORMATION

The Hale Ikena **will not accept packages** for this event. If you need to ship your booth supplies and/or equipment in, please ship these materials to your hotel and bring them over on the morning of the event.

We will have a dolly that you can use to transport your materials to and from the parking lot.
